The Winchester Mystery House is a well-known mansion in the state of California. It once was the personal residence of Sarah Winchester, the widow of businessman William Winchester. It was continuously under construction for 38 years and was thought to be haunted. Under Sarah Winchester's guidance, its construction proceeded around the clock, without interruption, from 1884 until her death on September 5, 1922. At that time, work immediately stopped. The cost for such constant building has been estimated at about U.S. \$5.5 million, if paid for in 1922. In today's dollars, it would be over \$75 million dollars.

Note: Students may write options that make sense both grammatically and semantically, but are different from the passage here. Cloze tests require that the instructor evaluate the choices students make individually, and not just from the key.
